INTRODUCTION

Portnox CLEAR is a cloud-based Software as a Service, which provides secure network access control for corporate devices, BYOD, and IoT, as well as employees, contractors and quests, across any multivendor wired, wireless and VPN infrastructure.

At a high level, Portnox CLEAR offers the following license options (described in detail below):

- **Evaluation** A free 45-day trial subscription plan, with all capabilities enabled. To keep the solution operational, the organization must upgrade to one of the paid subscription tiers (Essentials or Enterprise) before trial expiration.
- Two base subscription tiers, depending on the customer network layer and use case:
- O **Essentials** subscription tier includes features for secure wireless access.
- Enterprise subscription tier includes features for both wireless and wired secure access, including advanced device profiling and eco system plug-ins.
- Various add-on licenses for additional functionality on top of any paid base subscription tier, depending on the intended use case:
 - AgentP provides endpoint continuous risk posture assessments over wireless, wired and VPN connections
 - O Local Radius provides local radius proxy for high availability
 - Multi-regional cloud-based Radius instances
 - O Network Device Administration AAA\TACACS+ services (coming soon)
 - Extended device data retention package
 - Extended Guest account packageo Extended SMS package
 - O Premium 24x7 level support
 - Onboarding packages

BASE SUBSCRIPTION TIERS

The Portnox CLEAR base subscription tiers are considered the base license for the entire organization and therefore cannot be mixed. The base subscription tier is available in one of two types – Essentials or Enterprise.

See Appendix A for a full summary of the features available for each type.

Each base tier offers a different set of capabilities to best address the main access control use cases, as well as define the number of allowed devices.

License consumption is based on the number of unique network-connected devices (including BYOD, managed devices and IoT). Device uniqueness is generally determined either by the AgentP installed on devices, or by unique MAC addresses.

Devices are considered inactive and removed from the CLEAR license only if they had not accessed the corporate network for the past 4 days. Alternatively, devices can be manually removed using the CLEAR portal's **Devices page**. Data regarding removed devices is archived.

In addition, Portnox CLEAR allows organizations to be temporarily over-provisioned, with up to 20% additional connected devices on top of the license quota, so temporarily exceeding the quota does not block devices out of the network.

The organization's admin can monitor the acquired subscription tier, expiration date and quotas on the CLEAR portal's **Help > Subscription Plan** page.

Features and capabilities that are not available in the chosen subscription tier are greyed out in the portal. Static data is visible but no actions can be executed on it. License includes built-in standard support during business hours

Volume Tiers available:

Portnox CLEAR subscription volume Tier is determined by the total number of devices under license:

- O Less than 500 devices
- O Between 500 and 999 devices
- O Between 1000 and 2499 devices
- O Between 2500 and 4999 devices
- O Between 5000 and 9999 devices
- O Above 10,000 devices

Payment terms options:

Portnox CLEAR subscription can be purchased in few payment terms:

- Yearly subscription contract
- 3 years' pre-paid contract
- 5 years' pre-paid contract

Essentials License

Essentials license includes features designed to secure and control access to wireless networks. See <u>Appendix A</u> for a full summary of the features available in this tier. The Essentials base subscription tier can be upgraded to the Enterprise tier at any time during the subscription period.

Enterprise License

The Enterprise license includes features designed to secure and control access to both wired and wireless networks, including advanced device profiling and eco system plug-ins. See <u>Appendix A</u> for a full summary of the features available in this tier.

ADD-ON LICENSES

Portnox CLEAR offers few types of 'add-on' licenses that can be purchased on top of any paid base subscription tier. See Appendix B for a full summary of the features available as add-ons.

AgentP License

The AgentP license offers an agent for Windows, OSX, Android, iOS and Linux devices, which provides endpoint continuous risk posture assessments and risk-based access to wireless, wired and VPN layers. The AgentP license is consumed per each enrolled and registered device agent. Removal of AgentP from the device, removes it also from the license.

Local Radius

The Local Radius add-on provide an on-prem Radius Proxy module for high availability and local fail-over in cases of internet outage

Multi-regional cloud-based Radius instances

Portnox CLEAR cloud service enables radius instance setup in few different geographic locations such as North America, Europe and Asia to meet customer geo-restriction rules and enhanced performance requirements

Network Device Administration

The Network Device Administration add-on offers on-prem AAA\TACACS+ service module to manage network gear across the corporate network.

Extended device data retention package

The Extended device data retention add-on offers 3 additional months' worth of device historical access and risk data. Extended Guest Account Package

Extended Guest Account Package

The Extended Guest Account package offers an additional 50 authenticated guest accounts per day accessing via Captive Portal or 3rd party Radius server (e.g. Eduroam guests)

Extended SMS Package

The Extended SMS package offers 1000 additional SMS-based guest onboarding.

Premium Support License

The Premium Support license offers extended 24x7 support, compared with the default support level which includes business hours only. This license must be applied to all devices under the base subscription.

Onboarding packages (professional Services)

Portnox onboarding services offer various packages per deployment. These include:

- Basic No cost. Up to 200 devices.
- O Advanced \$1,000. Up to 1,000 devices.
- Premium \$1,500. Up to 5,000 devices.
- White Glove \$3,500. 5,000+ devices.
